## ST. PATRICKS DAY recipes & fun



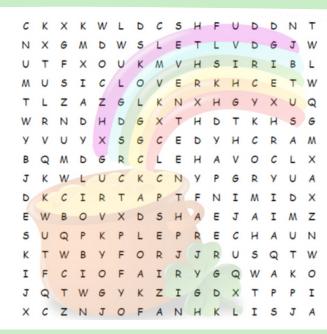
**DID YOU KNOW?**

## ST. PATRICK'S DAY **WORD SEARCH**

Clover Irish Luck Patrick Fairy Jig

March Seventeenth Green Leprechaun Music Shamrock







#### **Ingredients**

- 4 russet potatoes (2 to 2 1/2 pounds), peeled & cut into large chunks
- Salt
- · 5 to 6 tablespoons unsalted butter, plus more for serving
- · 3 lightly packed cups chopped kale, cabbage, or chard
- 3 green onions, minced (about 1/2 cup)
- · 1 cup milk or cream

#### Instructions

- 1. Boil the potatoes: Put the potatoes in a medium pot and cover with cold water by at least an inch. Add 2 tablespoons of salt, and bring to a boil. Boil until the potatoes are fork tender, 15 to 20 minutes. Drain in a colander.
- 2. Cook the greens and the green onions with butter: Return the pot to the stove and set over medium-high heat. Melt the butter in the pot and once it's hot, add the greens. Cook the greens for 3 to 4 minutes, or until they are wilted and have given off some of their water. Add the green onions and cook 1 minute more.
- 3. Mash the potatoes with milk or cream and greens: Pour in the milk or cream, mix well, and add the potatoes. Reduce the heat to medium. Use a fork or potato masher and mash the potatoes, mixing them up with the greens.
- 4. Add salt to taste and serve hot, with a knob of butter in the center.
